Area. Whilst this is not criminal damage the destruction of the wild flowers means that the insects that would have fed on them can no longer do so. Only days before an array of insect life



had been noted on the lovely yellow Great Mullein flowers. These tall flowers are the main food of the Mullein moth. Please could those responsible give some thought to the efforts that have gone into making this a successful conservation area which continues to attract an ever increasing amount of wildlife.
